Kundan Green Energy's Employees Rescued in Sikkim

Gangtok, October 11th 2023: In a news update, Kundan Green Energy said its employees at Rabum Chu have been rescued by the authorities and the ITBP. After an initial day/night at the ITBP facility the rescued employees have been sent to Mangan. Sharing the update, the company expressed its deep and sincere gratitude to the Government and the ITBP for the rescue.

Kundan Green Energy's site was impacted by the glacial lake outburst flood (GLOF) in Lhonak Lake, Sikkim. These massive floods had impacted the Rabum Chu 20 MW project. The Kundan Green Energy personnel were stranded on site with no communication and all accessibility cut-off due to landslides, waterlogging and infrastructural collapse. While otherwise safe, they were completely isolated and eagerly awaiting rescue. The company had been following up with the authorities for the rescue. With four operating projects totaling 35 MW in the state of Sikkim at Lower Lagyap, Meyong Chu, Kalex Khola, and Rabum Chu, besides two upcoming projects at Lower Meyong Chu and New Meyong Chu, Kundan Green Energy is a major energy partner to the state of Sikkim.
